I hear it all the time......where does the time go? It seems like yesterday I was trying to get some Christmas cards out to friends living on the west coast and those up in New England. I think yesterday was when I started thinking about the amount of ice melt I stored for winter. I thought I had more time to get everything ready for the end of the first quarter of 2023. I write the date numerous times a day and still I look at what is there with disbelief!

Winter is still here. Spring is fast approaching. There are buds on the pussy willows, and the clump of snowdrops on the edge of my property have sent up their slender bright green leaves. In a few weeks, the forsythia will have flowered. If you look carefully, the hills here in Pennsylvania will start looking a little red as the leaf buds begin their unfurling. Yes, it's still winter, and snow and ice may still fall, yet spring will be upon us as sure as Lent follows Epiphany! There are numerous signs of spring where ever you look, meaning signs of Lent are there too.
