


THRU THE HANDS OF GOD ONE HAND HELPING ANOTHER (North Parish's Mission Statement)



"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen."

Luke 24:5-6

What wondrous words to hear early in the morning on the first day of the week. Our scripture for Easter Day, however, tells us that Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James were terrified as two men in dazzling white clothes stood next to them and spoke the words. After all they had come to a tomb to apply burial spices to a dead body and the body was gone. Why are you surprised, they said, he told you in Galilee that he would be handed over to sinners, be crucified, and rise on the third day. Why are you surprised? Why are you surprised that new life has replaced the old?

The men in white might ask you and I the same question as we leave the wilderness of Lent behind, as we emerge from the valley of death of Good Friday, and as we begin new life in the resurrected Lord. Why are you surprised? After all, God's prophets told us everything that was going to happen. Why are you surprised that a loving God would reconcile himself to His creation and forgive all of their sins against Him and their fellow man so that they might have the opportunity for new and eternal life in and through His son, our Lord Jesus Christ. Why are you surprised?

As we move in to the great 50 days of the Easter might we ponder what it means to leave tainted and sinful lives behind among the dead and rise with Christ into the new and glorious lives he has intended for us since the beginning of time.

Are you still surprised? Why do you look for the living among the dead?

The minutes of the February 17, 2013 meeting were approved and the Treasurer's report for February 2013 was accepted as printed.
