From Fr. Tim's Desk

2 Thessalonians 3:13

In November 2010, on the eve of All Saints' Day the faithful gathered at the Assyrian Catholic Church of Our Lady of Salvation in Baghdad. As Father Wassim Sabih finished the mass, eight al-Qaida stormed in, began shooting and forced him to the floor. As the priest pleaded that his parishioners be spared, they executed him and began their mission of mass murder. When Iraqi security forces broke in, the killers threw grenades to finish off the surviving Christians and detonated explosive-laden vests to kill themselves and the police. The toll was 46 parishioners and two priests killed, 78 others critically wounded. How blessed were the parishioners of Our Lady of Salvation to be in the act of worshipping their Lord and Savior when their mortal lives came to an abrupt end. And it is their witness that drives home the message when the end time comes, our Lord and Savior does not expect us to be idle and sitting on the sidelines. He expects to find us engaged and doing the work that he has given us to do.

In a few weeks we will begin a new church year with the first Sunday of Advent, a season in which we prepare for the second coming of Christ. Of course no one knows when that glorious day will be. In the first century it was a common understanding that the persecution that was being endured by the church was fulfillment of prophesy so Christ's second coming must be imminent and there were many that actually stopped or suspended their Christian behaviors because they perceived end was so near. Such was the church at Thessalonica and in his 2nd letter to them St. Paul encourages them to persist, that Christ's second coming might be a while yet. He urges them to carry on with the work that Christ had given them to do, not to be idle but to live by faith that Christ will come again and to live out their faith and spread the good news of the gospel every hour of every day until the day he comes. "Brothers and sisters, do not be weary in doing what is right."

In the year 2013 we are certainly closer to the Lord's second coming than was the church at Thessalonica, but like them we too are called to be ready. We are called to NOT be idle, to NOT be bystanders. We are called to be engaged in the Lord's work EVERY hour of EVERY day UNTIL he comes again. We are called to **BE** Christians. When He comes, may He find us **SO**.
