From Father Timos Desk

As we move into the month of October, we are rapidly approaching the end of Mark's gospel, a gospel that has been a series of one action after another. Immediately Jesus did this and immediately Jesus did that. Jesus is a man in motion, someone who has a clear vision of what he needs to do and how he is going to get there. Do we share that vision? Do we know what we need to do? Do we know how to get there? It has been a question asked for centuries. It is a question asked by a man who knelt before Jesus and said, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus expounds on the ten commandments and the man replies, "Yes Lord, I've kept the law all my life", but Jesus looks him in the eye and says ""You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." When the man heard this, he was shocked and went away grieving, for he had many possessions.

How many of us could see ourselves in this man's place and wither and wilt away for we could not possibly entertain giving away everything that we own, or parting with many of the luxuries we enjoy? There is no doubt that some "attitude adjustments" would be required but as St. James reminded us in his epistle last month, we need to be doers of the word, not just those that hear it. We need to walk the talk and live out our faith in service to others and in service to the Lord. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me. I was naked and you gave clothing, I was sick and you cared for me, I was in prison and you visited me. And we may ask, Lord when did we see you hungry and fed you, or thirsty and gave you drink? And when was it we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you? And the Lord will answer us, truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of my family, you did it to me.

The treasure that we accumulate here on earth cannot go with us into eternal life, but the treasure we lay up in heaven, in service to the Lord, in service to others, on behalf of the least of them, that treasure grows and grows and awaits our arrival.

Be doers of the word, then come and follow me. Can you do that?

Thank you for your generous support with this ministry. If you are in need of food assistance, please call the church office at 874-4532 and we will direct you to a local food pantry.






